B.ADMISSION AND ELIGIBILITY

1. Admissions to all online programmes shall be made in four cycles, every year, as under:

Sr.No.	Admission Cycle	Period
1.	First	January 1 to March 31
2.	Second	April 1 to June 30
3.	Third	July 1 to September 30
4.	Fourth	October 1 to December 31

The online admissions/examinations arrangement shall be executed in accordance with the Regulations of the University as amended and notified from time to time.

2. A candidate seeking admission to the course leading to the award of a Certificate/Diploma/Bachelor's Degree shall fulfill the following conditions:

Passed senior secondary examination on the pattern of 10+2 in any discipline, from a recognized Board of education or 3-Year Diploma from the Board of Technical Education, Haryana after Matriculation or an equivalent examination recognized by M.D. University.

3. A candidate seeking admission to the course leading to the award of Post-graduate Diploma/Master's degree shall fulfill any of the following conditions:

Passed Bachelor's/Master's Degree in any discipline of this University or equivalent thereto and approved by the UGC/AIU or any regulatory Body constituted/established by the Act of Parliament/Central Government/State Government.

4. A candidate having compartment in the qualifying examination, mentioned under clause 2 and 3 above, shall also be considered for admission, and shall be awarded certificate/diploma/degree as per the University Regulations.
